CHAPTER X

JOHN EWIN OF BURLINGTON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

HIS WILL OF 11 AUGUST 1732 [No EWING marriages are shown in New Jersey earlier than 1745]

John EWIN of Springfield, Burlington Co., N.J. wrote his will 11 August 1732. It is located in Liber 3 page 218 of the Calendar of Wills of New Jersey. It was proved 12 October, 1732 #2231C and the Inventory of his Goods and Chattels was taken on 19 October, 1732 #2233C.

He willed to his sons Absolom and Ambrose all his Real Estate when they become of age. Wife, Mary to be executrix.

Marriages in New Jersey show the following:

- Ambrose Ewan of Burlington married Ann Trenton 30 April 1739
- Absalome Ewan of Burlington married Rachel Grant 1 July, 1764
- Absalom Ewing of Burlington married Kesiah Taylor 6 March, 1778
- Moses Ewan of Burlington married Rebecca Stokesbury 1 May, 1782

There are five other EWAN men of Burlington who married in this later time frame. Only one time was the name spelled EWING.

Wills of New Jersey show the following in Burlington Co:

- Ambrose Ewan-Intestate Account and Inventory 22 May, 1762. He was of Northampton, Burlington Co., N.J. No wife and children named but the 18 May 1763 Account charges: "10 shillings for taking children to burial."
- · Absolom Ewan Will is dated 25 October 1768. He mentions sons David, Levi and Absolom, Jr. and son-in-law John Lame.

We recently became aware of a Genealogy, possibly of this family. As yet we have not accessed this information.
