

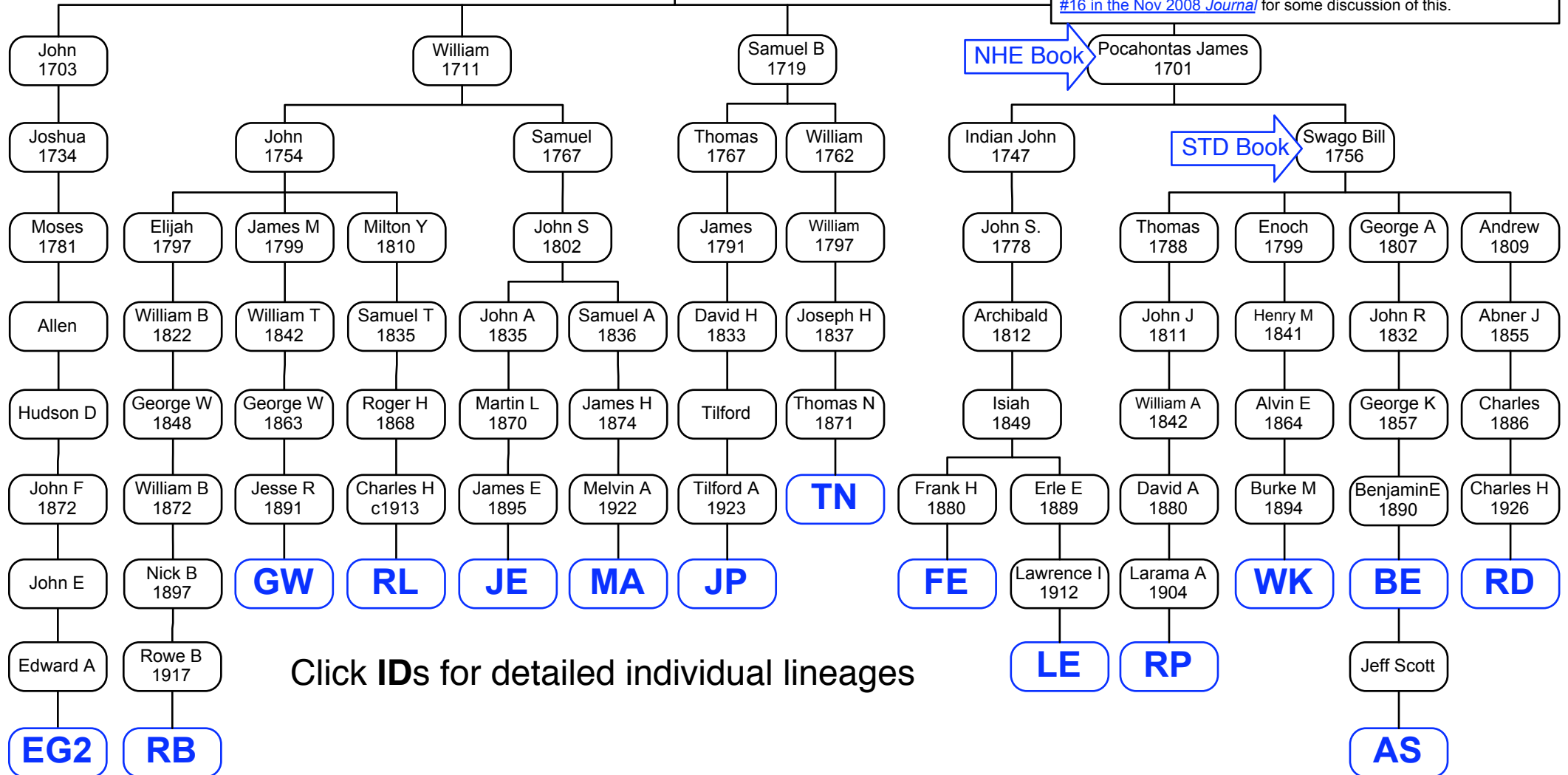

John Ewing of Carnashannagh, Donegal
b. 1648

It is not well established and controversial whether Pocahontas James Ewing b 1722 was in fact a son of John Ewing of Carnashannagh. Please notice that all of his descendants in this diagram share the mutation YCA IIb = 22, which John of Carnashannagh could not have had, but it is possible that this occurred in Pocahontas James himself.
